DETAILED NOTICE INVITING TENDER

1. On line Tenders in the prescribed form as uploaded on website are hereby invited from the enlisted contactors for the work of (I) **Raising of concrete muffs and offchutes for 220 KV RSD- Sarna Ckt 3&4 Line.** from the website [www.eproc.punjab.gov](http://www.eproc.punjab.gov.in), EMD shall be deposited online.
2. Only e-tendering mode will be acceptable. The e-tender should be submitted through online mode on the website (<https://eproc.punjab.gov.in/nlcgep/app>) or www.eproc.punjab.gov
3. Eligibility Criteria :
To qualify for getting himself registered with www.eproc.punjab.gov, each bidder in its name should have achieved following mile stones:

- (i) Average Annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
- (ii) Experience of having successfully completed similar works during the last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:
 - (a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost. Or
 - (b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost. Or
 - (c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
- (iii) Similar work means **Repair of stubs, offchutes, raising of muffs; Construction of 132KV/220KV/400KV transmission lines.**

4. Bid Capacity:

The available Bid Capacity at the expected time of bidding (to be calculated on the basis of prescribed format vide Annexure 1 & 2) of the prospective applicant shall not be less than the Estimated amount put to tender of intended job.

The bid capacity of the prospective bidders will be calculated as under:
Assessed Available Bid Capacity = $(A \cdot N^2 - B)$

Where

- A = Maximum value of Civil Engineering works executed in any one year during the last five years taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.
B = Value of existing commitments and on-going works to be completed during the period of completion of the projects for which these bids are being invited.
N = The time period which varies from work to work, however most of works of WRD do fall in category N=0.5 (Value considered as per SBD for World Bank Projects)
The general formula is as detailed below:-

If, Completion period ≤ 6 months, N= 0.5 Therefore,
Bid capacity = $A \cdot 0.5^2 - B = A - B$

If, $6 <$ Completion period ≤ 12 months, N= 1 Therefore,
Bid capacity = $A \cdot 1^2 - B = 2A - B$

If, $12 <$ Completion period ≤ 18 months, N= 1.5 Therefore,
Bid capacity = $A \cdot 1.5^2 - B = 3A - B$

If, $18 <$ Completion period ≤ 24 months, N= 2 Therefore,
Bid capacity = $A \cdot 2^2 - B = 4A - B$

And similar exercise be done as the case may be.

Note: The statement showing the value of existing commitments and ongoing works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be signed by the Engineer-in Charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent.

5. The time allowed for completion of work will be **3 Months** after the date of issue of letter of intent or Allotment Letter to the firm whichever is earlier.
6. **a.) Earnest Money:**
The tenderers shall be required to submit 2% of tendered amount (Minimum Rs. 22,700/- for Earnest Money through online mode.
- b.) PROCESSING FEE:**
The bidders have to pay the processing fee as per the directions issued by Directorate of Governance reforms and Public grievances (Govt. of Punjab). For details refer to the relevant documents attached in Other documents.
7. Five percent security will be deducted from the running bills of the contractor.
8. The rates shall be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of the Tender. The earnest money shall be forfeited if the tenderer withdraws or modifies his offer within the validity period or fails to sign the (Formal Contract) agreement after acceptance of his offer or fails to commence the work within ten days of issue of acceptance letter. The earnest money will be forfeited.
9. On acceptance of the tender, the firm shall arrange the availability of an accredited representative, fully authorized in writing at the site of work to receive instructions of the Engineer-in-charge or his representative and to ensure prompt compliance thereof.
10. The Competent Authority does not bind itself to accept the lowest rate or any tender and reserves to itself, the right of accepting the whole or part of the tender and tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the quoted rates.
11. Before filling the tender, the site shall be visited by the representative of the firm and satisfy itself as to the conditions prevalent there especially regarding accessibility to the site, nature and extent of the ground, working conditions, stacking of materials, installation of Tools and Plants etc. accommodation and movement of labour, supply of water and power for satisfactory completion of the works contract. No Claim, what so ever, on such account shall be entertained by the department in any circumstances.
12. The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender and the department shall in no case be liable for these costs.
13. GST applicable as per Govt. Norms and shall be paid extra by PSTCL.
14. Each tenderer shall submit only one tender, either by himself or as partner in a joint venture. A tenderer who submits or participates in more than one tender, will be disqualified.
15. Unless otherwise stated the contract shall be for the whole work as described in the "Schedule of items of works". The contractor shall be bound to complete the whole work as described in the schedule of items of works including the additional items if any, as per

Instructions. The certificate of completion as issued by the Engineer-in-Charge shall be the conclusive proof of completion of work.

16. The tenderer has to fill the tender form as given by the department. The scanned copy of the following documents shall accompany the tenders. If required by the department they can ask for the original copy for verification from the tenderer.

- (i) Registration Certificate of the firm or company
- (ii) Allotted EPF Code Number from Employees Provident Fund Commissioner and latest copy of challan of Deposit of EPF of the employees. Or L&C Societies with employee strength of less than 20 employees are exempted from EPF scheme. In such cases, they should submit an affidavit or EPF exemption certificate issued by the competent authority.
- (iii) PAN Number
- (iv) Bid Capacity as per sr. No. 4
- (v) Experience Certificate as per sr. No. 3
- (vi) GST Number
- (vii) Solvency certificate (Tenderers shall produce a solvency certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank, should not be older than one year and amounting Rs. 12 lakhs.
- (viii) Turnover/Competency certificate.

17. The Tenderer should possess the requisite documents before the date of publishing of this Tender.

18. Incomplete tender or tenderers not fulfilling any of the conditions specified above are liable to be rejected without assigning any reason.

19. Tenderers will have to comply with all rules & regulations under Factory Act, Industrial dispute Act, EPF Act, Labour Laws Bonus Act & Retrenchment Act on his appointment for the above said work.

20. The Co-op. L&C Societies must attach in the documents the NOC taken from the concerned Assistant Registrar of Co-Op Societies of the Dist., where the work is to be executed.
