## Minimum Educational Qualifications a)

CA/ICWA/CFA/CPA or MBA in Finance

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized university and should hav passed Sectional Officer Grade examination conducted by CAG of India or SA' examination conducted by the State Government/PSPCL or similar entities;

## **Qualifying Service** b)

Serving/Retired Officers of the Central/State Government or PSU under State/Central Government must have experience of working as Accounts Officer or equivalent in th pay scale of 15600-39100 + 5400 Grade Pay.

Minimum 5 years regular service as SAS Acett./AAO or equivalent posts

## c) Nature of Experience

Having knowledge of State/Central Government Accounting procedure such as the procedural details for budget, drawing and disbursement, receipts and payments, statutory recoveries, fund etc., their accounting and the financial control.
