Mohali as Cost Auditors of Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited made by the Board of Directors of the Corporation, to conduct the audit of the cost records of the Corporation for the financial year 2017-18, at a lump sum remuneration of Rs. 25,000/-(Rs. Twenty Five Thousand only) inclusive of TA/DA and all taxes as set out in the Statement annexed to the Notice be and is hereby ratified.

Explanatory Statement in respect of the agenda to the business to be transacted at the Annual General Meeting of PSTCL.

Ordinary Business

Item No.1 Status of Audited Financial Statements of Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited for FY 2016-17.

Chief Financial Officer, PSTCL vide his office memo No. 3296/ CFO/A&R-147 dated 01.08.2017 intimated that:

- i. Statutory Audit of Annual accounts of the Corporation for FY 2016-17 is still in progress, which is likely to take time. Thereafter Supplementary audit by CAG under Section 143(6)(a) of Companies Act, 2013 shall be carried out.
- ii. Tariff order for FY 2017-18 (along with True-up upto FY 2015-16 and review of FY 2016-17) is still to be announced by PSERC.
- iii. The Annual accounts of FY 2016-17 is required to be Ind AS compliant on the basis of notification of MCA. The consultant appointed for this purpose are on the job and yet to finalize the impact study. Further conversion of annual accounts as per Ind AS as on 01.04.2015, 31.03.2016 and 31.03.2017 is required, which will take time.

In view of the above, the audited financial statements of the Corporation for FY 2016-17 along with report of Statutory Auditors/C&AG of India and Directors Report will not be available for adoption in the 7th Annual General Meeting. Therefore, the Shareholders may consider to adjourn the 7th AGM which will be reconvened on receipt of audited financial statements for FY 2016-17 together with the reports of the auditors and Board of Directors.

Item No. 2

Pursuant to section 139 of the Companies Act, 2013, the auditors of the Government Company are to be appointed or re-appointed by the Comptroller and Auditors General of India(C&AG) and as per provisions of section 142 of the Companies Act, 2013, their remuneration has to be fixed by the Company in the Annual General Meeting or in such manner as the company in general meeting may determine.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 142(1) of the Companies Act, 2013, the members of Corporation in its 6th Adjourned Annual General Meeting held on 7th October, 2016 authorized Board of Directors of the Corporation to fix the remuneration and other terms and conditions including reimbursement of out of pocket expenses in connection with the audit work of Statutory Auditors as appointed by C&AG for FY 2016-17.

Accordingly, Board of Directors in its 39th meeting held on 26th December, 2016 has fixed audit fee of Rs. 3,00,000/-(Rs. Three Lacs only) excluding of service tax which shall be paid extra and out of pocket expenses of M/S Rajiv Goel and Associates , 179, Bank Road, Ambala appointed by C&AG as Statutory Auditors of the corporation for FY 2016-17. Statutory Auditors and its staff will be entitled for reimbursement of TA/DA and hotel charges for performing journeys within Punjab and Chandigarh, where the auditors have no head office or branch office for conducting the Statutory Audit of the books of accounts of PSTCL, at the rates specified in TA Regulations as amended from time to time as per

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entitlement of the officers/staff of the Corporation along with hotel charges outside Punjab and Chandigarh. For the purpose of TA/DA, Auditors and its staff will be categorised as under:-

Reimbursement of the hotel charges will be subject to non-availability of guest houses of PSPCL and PSTCL.

Statutory Auditors of PSTCL for FY 2017-18 are yet to be appointed by C&AG of India.

Members of the Corporation are requested to note the remuneration including reimbursement of out of pocket expenses fixed by the Board for FY 2016-17 as mentioned above and authorize Board of Directors of PSTCL to fix an appropriate remuneration of Statutory Auditors appointed by C&AG for the year 2017-18 including reimbursement of out of pocket expenses as may deem lit.

Special Business

Item No. 3

Pursuant to Rule 14 of the Companies (Audit and Auditors) Rules, 2014 read with Section 148(3) of the Companies Act, 2013, the remuneration recommended by the Audit committee shall require to be considered and approved by the Board of Directors and ratified subsequently by the shareholders.

Based on the recommendations of the Audit Committee, the Board of Directors of PSTCL in its 42nd meeting held on 13th June, 2017 followed by 43rd meeting held on 08.08.2017 has approved the appointment of M/s Pawan & Associates, 702, Block D-3, Maya Garden City, Zirakpur, Distt. Mohali as a Cost Auditor of Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited for FY 2017-18 at a lump sum remuneration of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand only) inclusive of TA/DA and all taxes.

Accordingly, members are requested to ratify the remuneration payable to Cost Auditors for the financial year 2017-18.
