"We must record herein our dissatisfaction in the manner in which the officials deputed by the respondents to assist the learned

counsel representing the respondents, as also, to assist this Court, miserably failed in discharging their duties in a responsible

manner. On certain occasions the record sought was not produced. It is only after the intervention of the learned Advocate General,

Punjab, that the record has been produced before this court today. Precious court time has unjustifiably been wasted just because of

the officials deputed by the respondents to assist the learned

counsel representing the respondents, as also, to assist this Court,

miserably failed in discharging their duties in a responsible

manner. The relevant observations as recorded by the Hon'ble High Court are reproduced as under:

order of court will be forwarded to you and to the concerned officials of the

respondents. In the circumstances of this case, we consider it just
and appropriate to require the respondent to ensure that officials
dealing with the concerned cases as well as the court are well
informed with the controversy involved and are always debriefed with
the entire original record pertaining to the controversy.

In view of the above, you are hereby advised to ensure strict
compliance of the observations of the Hon'ble High Court by all your
subordinates handling the court cases to study the cases properly and put up
the entire original record in the courts and when demanded it may also be
ensured that only those officials may be present in the court and to be
assisted learned counsels who are even conversant with the case and will give necessary
information and the facts in the cases and the observations of the court.
